* New Equipment

In our efforts to continue to provide you with all the diagnostic options and therapies necessary to keep you performing at the highest level, we added several new pieces of equipment to our armamentarium. Available at all the locations are the following:

- **Dynamic Endoscope** A digital, portable endoscope fitted to a horse's halter or bridle that allows for evaluation of upper airway function while performing. The dynamic scope works in environments from racing to jumping. We will be able to diagnose much more subtle changes in airway function specific to different disciplines that are impossible to find standing still. This new scope perfectly complements our **Lameness Locator**, the computerized gait analysis, which lets us evaluate a horse's gait for asymmetry, picking up the slightest lameness not normally visible.
- Nd:YAG LASER A surgical instrument allowing our surgeons to precisely operate on tissues only accessible via the endoscope. We can address problems in the upper airway that impact performance and tackle issues affecting mare fertility such as uterine cysts in a much less invasive manner. We will be able to perform more surgeries, with less sedation, and faster recoveries.
- **Portable Gastroscope** This 4-foot long, battery-powered endoscope is completely portable making it easier to diagnose stomach ulcers and other stomach issues on the farm and in the clinic.
- * BVEH Vet Supply In November we rolled out our own online pharmacy to help provide you with the flexibility of buying drugs online, but also the security of knowing what you are purchasing has been handled correctly. Don't see what you need there is also a Contact/Request box to ask and the VetSupply will find whatever you need.
